Sergio Leone's classic film about Jewish boys from the ghettos who rose into prominence in New York City's organized crime, *Once Upon A Time in America*; Guiseppe Tornatore's romantic drama movie, *Cinema Paradiso*; Quentin Tarantino's films, *Kill Bill Vol. 2* and *Inglourious Basterds*. We know that all of these films were some of the most terrific movies shown on the silver screen, but what we didn't know particularly was that all of these share one commonality between each other. All the movies mentioned were scored by the Italian composer and conductor, Ennio Morricone.

Maestro Ennio Morricone is now enjoying the title of being the World's most famous film composer. He currently has approximately 500 film scores that contribute to the overall flavour of the delightful movies that we see. Without Morricone's genius, it is doubtful whether the scenes that made a lasting mark in the history of film can still evoke the same kind of emotions on the part of the audience. Simply put, the Italian plays a very significant role in the entire film-making process.

While primarily being known as a composer for film, he also delves in other branches of music throughout his career. He makes the artsy 'absolute music', as well as being conductor and orchestrator in the recording field, and composer for theatre and radio productions. From solely composing background music for radio dramas when he was in his younger years, Morricone is now a truly accomplished and decorated individual with many musical awards (Grammy Award, 3 Golden Globes, Honorary Oscar Award, European Film Award, etc.) attached across his name.

This year, Ennio Morricone will celebrate his 50th year of making fine music and one of the places included in the touring list will be here in Seoul. Starting on May 16, he is set to perform at the Sejong Center for the Performing Arts that will run until the 18th. Accompanying the Maestro will be Korea's Philharmonic Orchestra and Choir as well as

fellow Italians, Gilda Butta and Susanna Rigaci. Tickets are sold from W40,000 up to W220,000.
